Commitments PIG MINIMUM STANDARD

By 2030, 100% of the Restoleil Group's pork supply (fresh, frozen, and processed) will come from farms that :

- Comply with the provisions of the decree of 16 January 2003 establishing minimum standards for the protection of pigs, meaning they:
 - do not practice routine tail docking, routine teeth clipping or grinding of piglets, or castration of piglets without anesthesia;
 - provide animals with **permanent access to manipulable materials** in sufficient quantity and quality; suboptimal materials and low-interest materials, as defined in Commission Recommendation (EU) 2016/336 of 8 March 2016, **may never be used alone**.
- Use no cages at any point during the sows' gestation and farrowing phases.

 Compliance with the above requirements will be ensured through the annual publication of a progress report.

This commitment applies to all our establishments.
